## TIMEKEEPING ROSTER ON PAGE 2

Dear Parents and Swimmers

Ivanhoe Neons will be fielding a very strong team at the Victorian Championships this year, with almost 30 swimmers competing.

Under the new Swimming Victoria rules each club, based on their overall number of entries, has to field a required number of timekeepers per session (including finals). Failing to comply will result in heavy penalties to the club. Based on our 30 competitors, our club is required to field 3 timekeepers per session.

The implication of this rule is that Ivanhoe Neons need parents to fill 60 slots over the duration of the meet. In light of this, we have drawn up a timekeeping roster. Every effort has been made to allocate sessions to you where your child will be swimming. Unfortunately, this has not always been possible, as certain sessions have less than three Neons swimmers. Although this might not suit you personally, please appreciate that this has been a huge juggling exercise to accommodate finals and heats and no family has been given preference. The number of children per family and also the number of swims per child has been taken into consideration when drawing up the roster, hence some families are doing more sessions than others. We hope you will be understanding and assist in the spirit of "Club Mateship" we have at Ivanhoe Neons.


**The attached roster has been drawn up and indicates the sessions that each family is required to timekeep.**
